Turnberry Country Club - Dress Code for Members & Guests

(Dress Code will be strictly enforced - inappropriately dressed patrons will be asked to leave)

Acceptable Attire

Tailored Trousers, Golf Shorts, Cargo Short and Skirts of Appropriate Length Shirts with Collars or Rounded Necks – Tucked In

Unacceptable Attire

Jeans or Denim of Any Kind, Cargo Pants, Cut-offs, Gym Cloths and Sweats Tank Shirt, T-Shirts and Halter Tops

- 1. Jeans are not acceptable at any Club facility. Denim fabric clothing (pants, jeans, skirts, jackets, shorts, etc.) of any color, cut-offs, torn or faded clothing, half-shirts, or tee shirts with inappropriate pictures or messages are not acceptable in any areas of the club.
- 2. Gentlemen and boys must wear slacks or shorts (minimum of 15 inches from waist to bottom of shorts) and shirts with sleeves and collars or full mock neck shirts. At no time are tank shirts, tee shirts, blue jeans or other denim clothing, cut-offs, sweat clothes or gym shorts allowed.
- 3. Gentlemen and boys should remove their hats inside of the clubhouse, with the exception of the pro shop, locker and card room, and the member bar/lounge.
- 4. Ladies and girls must wear slacks, shorts (minimum of 15 inches from waist to bottom of shorts) or golf skirts. Shirts can be with or without sleeves and may be round neck or have collars. At no time are tank tops, scoop neck, halter-tops, tee shirts, denim fabric clothing, sweat clothes or gym shorts allowed.
- 5. Members should realize that it is not possible to stipulate exactly the type of clothing that is appropriate, but all Members agree to abide by the intent of the Rules and Regulations and cooperate accordingly.
- 6. Members carry full responsibility for informing their guests of our dress code. If a guest is dressed inappropriately, service may be denied unless cover-up clothing is worn. The pro shop carries appropriate attire.

Turnberry Country Club Code of Conduct for Members & Guests

- 1. Rules of the United States Golf Association govern play along with any posted local rules.
- 2. No golfer shall endanger the safety of other players and shall wait until players ahead are out of range.
- 3. Repair all divots, ball marks, and tap down spike marks on the greens. Use the sand mixture provided on the carts to fill divots.
- 4. Smooth out all footprints and club marks in the bunkers with provided rake. Do not walk up the face of bunkers. Rakes should be place inside of a bunker, along the edge.
- 5. Do not apply bug spray or sunscreen to yourself while standing in the tee box, on the greens or fairways.
- 6. Obey all signage on the course, including when to return your cart to the path.
- 7. No more than one (1) golfer may play out of a single golf bag.
- 8. Respect the home owner's property by not driving your cart on private property. Do not attempt the heroic shot over their property. Public bathrooms are located in the Clubhouse and between Holes 2 & 3 and Holes 12 & 13.
- 9. Do not delay play by searching for a lost ball for over five minutes.
- 10. No group larger than a foursome shall be permitted, except with approval of the golf staff.
- 11. Members living around the golf course are reminded that they must start their round of golf from the clubhouse and not start from their home. All rounds of golf must start on No. 1 tee unless the golf shop grants authorization to the contrary.
- 12. When the course is crowded, twosomes and threesomes may be asked to accept additional players to make up foursomes.
- 13. In order to encourage faster play, any group of players should permit the group behind them to play through if such golfers are unreasonably delayed and at least one hole is open ahead.
- 14. All members are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and courteous manner at all times. Management reserves the right to dismiss any and all parties from the premise for any reason if deemed necessary. Members are responsible for their guest's conduct.

15. Personal Coolers or Consumption of personal alcohol on the premises is NOT permitted and will NOT be tolerated.
