IMPORTANT REGATTA FACTS

- 1. Any group can enter a boat in the race. It need not be an entire neighborhood, etc. The only condition is that they must be residents of Brunswick Forest.
- 2. A boat must race in the water as decorated and judged. No decorations are allowed to be removed before the race.
- 3. Hammock Lake is less than 10 feet at the deepest point, with most places between 5-6 feet
- 4. Oars and kayak paddles are allowed.
- 5. The boat must be human-powered, but there is no maximum number of people allowed.
- 6. A boat builder need not be in the boat, but builders and rowers must be residents of Brunswick Forest.
- 7. The race course will be from a designated start line in the lake just off the beach nearest Shelmore Way to a turn at the first buoy, a short leg to a second buoy, and then back to the beach nearest Shelmore Way. The total race distance is approximately 300 yards.
- 8. There will there be a safety boat in the lake in case a boat sinks.
- 9. There are NO alligators in the lake.
- 10. A life jacket is absolutely required for each rower.
- 11. No clean-up of the boats will be provided. Each team is responsible for the removal of their vessel.
- 12. Communications about the details of the race will be handled by Michael Bowers who will communicate directly with the Team Captains and then they can pass the information along to their teammates. Michael can be reached at michaelhbowers@gmail.com.
- 13. Acceptable supplies for building the boats are:
- cardboard
- tape
- glue
- water sealant (use is restricted to rubber cement, Liquid Nails, and/or latex Dri-Lok)
- paint and decorations

Any other items are strictly prohibited.
