Girls work with a PGA or LPGA Instructor to learn the basics in rules, etiquette, full swing, short game, and putting. The program:

- Creates a network in which girls feel comfortable in golf

### Levels of Play

Level 1 – New golfer

Level 2 – Can play 9 holes instruction and is  
prepared to go on a course. Play will be 9  
holes from approximately 125 yards each.

Level 3 – Can play 9 holes and averages 65-  
75 strokes on a regulation course. Will play  
9 holes from 125 yards in front of the  
forward tees.

Level 4 – Can play 9 holes averaging  
between 55-64 strokes on a regulation  
course. Will play 9 holes from the forward  
tee.

Level 5 – Plays 18 holes averaging 110  
strokes or better on a regulation course.  
Will play 18 holes from forward tees.

one Swing at a Time

Newark, Inc., in partnership with Union  
County conduct programs at Galloping Hill  
Learning Center. Participants are instructed  
by staff members of the LPGA-USGA Girls  
Golf in both golf and Life Skills that will  
benefit them off and on the course. Each  
week these principles will be reinforced  
through golf instruction.

The classes at Galloping Hill are taught at  
The Learning Center with 52 stalls, 20 of  
which are covered and heated, 46,000 square  
feet of putting and chipping areas, practice  
bunkers and a 9 hole practice course. This  
will give the girls a chance to be introduced  
to the game in this setting designed  
specifically for instruction, and then go out  
on the golf course the last few weeks of the  
program as their skills improve. Thank you

On course instruction on the 9 hole course is  
available for advanced players with a Pitch  
and Putt league at Ashbrook Golf Course in  
June and July.
