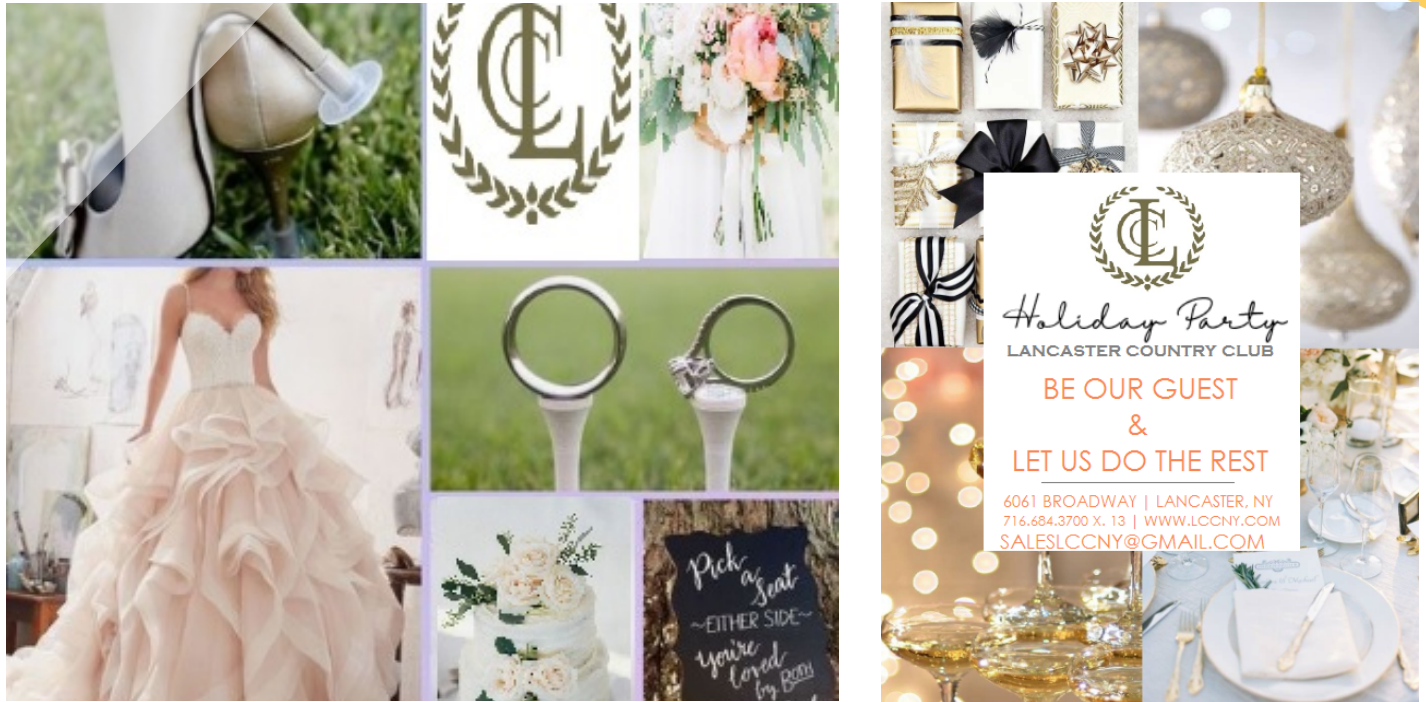
## FOOD & BEVERAGE | BRAD BUND
