**Golf Course Update** 

As the new golf season is upon us there are a few items I would like to discuss about the course.

The discrepancy in coloring of the greens is the difference between the bentgrass and the Poa annua. This will all change once the soil temperatures increase and they begin to grow. This past winter we had an above average snow total, but we also had melt offs during the course of the season. The off color to greens and to fairways is due to the wind.

All of the tree work performed this winter was Cayuga Heights and board approved. We continue tree work for several reasons including improved playability of a hole, to take down any dead or declining trees, and to improve the health of the turf. All stump holes will be filled and grassed over within the next few weeks as long as the weather stays cooperative.

We completed drainage on the side of twelve green along with adding drainage on five fairway. We also completed drainage work on the back of nine men's tee. These areas still need to be renovated which we will be addressing in the upcoming weeks.

We have been concentrating on debris pick up this past week, and it's close to completion. This was a major undertaking as several wind storms during the course of the winter dropped debris throughout the course.
