

A LETTER FROM THE GM | RAY TUGEND

"I hope that this edition of the Lancaster Newsletter finds you well. Over the past couple weeks we have been attempting to position the club in a much stronger financial state heading into 2019. The best way to ensure that this happens is through adding new members. In previous years there has been a membership promotion put in place right after Labor Day. This promotion included no dues through March of the following year. In lieu of this program we decided to bombard the market two months early. We are asking new members to pay \$500 for the remainder of the year and commit to annual dues starting in January.

Our cash flow and financial position will be stronger right from the start in 2019. To date we have enrolled 17 new golf members who will be paying full dues all 12 months in 2019. The net financial effect of this program is much stronger than the previous programs. Our goal is to generate enough subscription dues to cover the attrition from this year.

I would also like to remind you of the Annual Meeting to be held on July 19th. A financial review of the previous year will be presented along with addressing a few other areas of the club. My hope is to have a strong showing so that together we can continue to move forward in a unified manner. Lastly, I cannot thank you all enough for your feedback, opinions and guidance through the first four months of my tenure. It is always difficult stepping into a new club and learning the lay of the land. I am feeling much more comfortable with most aspects of the operation and truly feel blessed to be part of such a wonderful club.

Golf Course Reminders

Cart Usage

The agronomy team, Board of Directors and Management would kindly ask that all Members and their guests abide by the cart rules as posted by the golf shop. Over the past couple weeks there have been an increased amount of cart traffic in areas that should be protected. Carts are to be kept clear of all greens and areas short of the greens. The left side of #12 green is STRICTLY PROHIBITED! We will be forced to turn the cart monitoring system back on should the generally accepted guidelines not be adhered too.

Divots and Ball Marks

Please make sure to repair all of your divots and ball marks. If you are able to take a quick look around the area you are putting from and you see another ball mark please repair this as well. The greens at Lancaster Country Club are some of the best surfaces in all of Western New York, we want to make sure to keep them in that condition.

New Membership Offer Comparison

The Board of Directors and Management have recently issued a new membership offering. Here are the details of this offer:

\$500 plus tax for the remainder of the year (6-7 months)

MUST commit to 12 months of annual dues beginning in 2019

No assessments through 2019

Includes cart for 2019

We must get more members to start the 2019 year in an effort to avoid assessments, start an emergency fund for capital projects and potentially making some reductions in Primary A dues. As a comparison in September 2017 the following offer was promoted:

No dues until April (7 months free)
No fee for the remainder of the year
Dues commitment from April to December (9 months)
Includes cart
No assessments through the term

While this is a tremendous offer, we are asking for more money up front and an additional 3-month commitment than in prior years. Additionally, all of the new member dues will start in January which will make the club more financially secure than if the dues began in April.


