Grounds Update by Gary Powers

Fairways – We started to fix all the damaged turf on our fairways from the flooding we received this spring. These areas are either marked with cart signs or are roped off, please avoid driving over these areas until the signs or ropes are removed. Since we started the new fertilizing program on fairways I haven't seen a huge growth spurt in them like I have in the past. Slowing down the growth helps from a playability stand point but will also helps reduce the thatch layer. The more growth we push on fairways the more thatch we create.

18 Creek bed – If you have played the golf course over the past few weeks you may have noticed we have cleared the brush back off of the creek bank on 18. Next week we plan on hydro-seeding that area to a fescue grass. This will give the bank a more natural look. We plan on continuing down the bank towards the green to give 18 a more finished look. As we move forward we will look to other areas on the creek bed to expose letting you get a view of the creek as you play your round.

We started to spray clover but the weather forecast has been delaying the process. I have been hesitant to spray when weather reports are predicting rain because the herbicide needs to sit on the plant for 24 hours without any irrigation on it. Unfortunately the weather forecasts have been wrong more than they have been right. We will continue spraying our playing surfaces and the rough when there is no rain in the forecast.
