We are currently working with M&T Bank on refinancing the outstanding loan and we recently received good news that the challenging of the property/school taxes has gone in our favor and we were able to have the assessment reduced resulting in a saving to the club of over \$25,000 a year going forward. It seems that as we take these positive steps forward, we face other shortfalls. Through May 31<sup>st</sup>, we are down over 1,300 rounds of golf and cart fees are down over \$18,000 just to show a couple line items that have been affected by the weather this year. I want all members to know that the board is working in their best interest.

We still have many great events on the calendar this year. The best way to get full value out of your membership is to try some of them. My personal favorite is the LCC Invitational. There is a wait list, but for every 6 teams another flight will be created. I invite all membership to the club on Sunday July 21<sup>st</sup> at 3:00pm for the annual meeting. It will provide a breakdown of where the club stands financially and give our path to strengthening the club going forward. I look forward to seeing you there.




