

#### **Grounds Update** by Gary Powers

Just a reminder that starting with the ABCD event we will have new flag colors to identify front, middle, and back pin locations on greens. The new flags are colored on a diagonal; with one half a solid color the other half is white. A







front pin location will remain red/white, a middle pin location will be black/white, and a back pin location will be blue/white.

The weather has created a challenge to keep up with all the mowing out on the course. The spring weather also made it tough to predict when to spray our greens for poa annua seed head suppression. Our sand based greens have pushed out more seed heads than in any year that I have been here. To help create the best putting surface we can through this period we will brush and top-dress them more frequently.

This week we needle tined our greens. We will continue this practice monthly through the season. The small holes created by this process allows for air and gas exchange in the soil profile without a major disruption to the green surface.

With the wet conditions we have experienced this month it is imperative that occasionally we have cart restrictions. #### News from the Golf Shop

What's new for this season?!?! By now you have probably seen the messaging or driven one of the new golf cars. A new fleet of golf cars with GPS screen features has arrived. They will also have cart control geo fencing which will stop the cart when entering prohibited areas close to greens and tees. We have added a few items for short game practice. On the irons only side on the range, we have added targets at 20, 40, 60 and 80 yards measured from the middle of the range tee. These half flag targets will be put in play the first week of May and can be used to dial in your wedge game. For practicing the low, bump and run shots that do not leave a pitch mark on the practice putting green, we have Titleist ProV1, ProV1x or Bridgestone B330 balls in shag bags for use. They will be available in the golf shop to borrow and then return once completed with practice. Please do not take these golf balls home or on the course for practice or play. And lastly, we have a new Assistant Golf Professional in the golf shop this season. TJ Pezzulo comes to us from the Finger Lakes region. He is a graduate from the Golf Academy of America-Orlando and most recently worked at Seneca Falls Country Club. TJ and Brad will be more involved with clinics and camps this season, as well as private individual lessons.

#### Reminders as we start to ramp up for the new season:

Tee Times have begun and are available online. When booking a reservation, please fill out the member last name you are playing golf with. Please do not use "Member" as a place holder for the reservation. If you are bringing a guest to the club, you may put "Guest" as the player name. You can only have one guest in the foursome before 10:00 AM on weekend and Holidays. Please call the golf shop or go online to cancel your reservation if you are not able to make it. Our Membership roster has grown versus last season and the availability during busy times will be at a premium. Every effort will be made to pair up players into foursomes or threesomes during the busy times for pace of play assistance.

**Dress Code:** Please remind your guests before they come out to play of the most common oversights: shirts tucked in for men, no denim or jeans and newly approved by the Board last season, no cargo shorts or pants. Members and Guests will be expected to change or purchase shorts as cargo pockets will not be permitted on course. The golf shop will extend a discount to those needing to purchase shorts.

**On-Course Etiquette** of raking bunkers, filling divots and repairing ball marks on the green is always expected and appreciated as you play your round. Please be aware of your spacing on the course in relation to the group in front of you. If you see open room in front of your group and find players waiting on your group behind you, please invite them to play through at the first opportunity. Please refrain from cutting holes in front of groups or starting on the back 9 unless the golf shop gives you permission. If ordering food from the half way house, please pick up and continue play. If you sit to eat, you will lose your place on the course when busy and might be forced to start over on hole #1 if a tee time is available to finish your round. Finally, two golf carts per group, maximum please. If running late or coming at a different time then playing partners, our staff can give you a ride out to join your group already in progress.

If you ever have questions on any of the reminders or something else golf related, please ask Mike or Brad in the golf shop, as we are here to help with your golf experience.
