Garlic Powder ¼ cup
Brown Sugar ¼ cup
Cayenne Pepper (optional) Tbsp

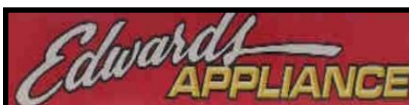
