CUT-OFF DATE

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS Conditions of Competition

Format

The Championships consist of an overall team championship and two separate team events conducted by stroke play over 72 holes at the Ocean Club Golf Course on Tuesday 26th, Wednesday 27th, Thursday 28th and Friday 29th July 2016, competed for by teams as follows:

Hoerman Cup - Teams selected by the national golf organizations which are members of CGA consisting of "six" amateur male golfers. The competition is individual stroke play with the lowest four scores of the five to count each day for the team.

The George Teale Memorial Trophy - Teams selected by the national golf organizations which are members of CGA consisting of "four" amateur female golfers. The competition is individual stroke play with the lower two scores of the three to count each day for the team.

In each case the lowest aggregate score over the competition will determine the winning team.

The Arthur Ziadie Trophy - An award of an overall trophy will be made to the country which has the most points accumulated in the two championships. In each of the championships, the team will be awarded points based upon the daily ranking of its aggregate counting scores, as follows:

Ranking 1st - Points equal to the number of teams competing plus one.

Ranking 2nd - Two points less than the leader.

Ranking 3rd - Three points less than the leader.

Ranking 4th - Four points less than the leader

and so on, until the last competing team which will be awarded 1 point. Teams tying will all be awarded the points for their ranking. The team with the most points in aggregate will win the trophy.

Substitution

Player substitution can only be made in any team up to that team's first starting time in the first round for that competition.



Rounds

Each of the championships shall be over 72 holes (4 rounds); however, should circumstances make it impossible to complete 72 holes, a championship may be determined by the results of 54 holes but on no account less.

Tees

Hoerman Cup - Green markers George Teale Memorial Trophy - Blue markers

Ties

In the event of a tie for any cup it shall be held equally.

Modification to Rules of Play and Conditions of Competition

(This Notice supplements the Rules of Play and Conditions of Competition applicable to all CGA Championships)

Practice

All recognized practice areas within the bounds of the course may be used by players for practice on any day of the competition. Between the play of two holes, a player must not make any practice stroke on or near the putting green of the hole last played and must not test the surface of the putting green of the hole last played by rolling a ball.

Advice

Each team competing in the Hoerman Cup and George Teale Trophy may appoint one person to be the Team Captain who may give advice to members of that team only. **The Captain must remain off the putting green at all times.** The Captain shall be identified to the Committee before giving advice and shall carry and display at all times the badge showing him to be the Captain. Any substitution of the Captain must be notified to the Committee. The Captain is considered a member of the team and not an outside agency. During a stipulated round, for any breach of a Rule by the Captain, the side involved incurs the applicable penalty.

Spectators

All persons other than the person designated to give advice are considered to be spectators. Spectators should remain on cart paths or in the rough and approximately 30 yards from the players. For the duration of the player's stipulated round, there shall be no communication between players and spectators that could be considered advice. If any such communication takes place, it shall be *prima facie* evidence of a breach of Rule 8 by the player.



Transportation

Only the following may drive or ride in a cart:

- officials,
- team coaches, and
- any other person with the permission of the Committee.

Otherwise the use of automotive transportation is prohibited; players in the Hoerman Cup and the George Teale Trophy must walk at all times.

Exceptions: (1) If a player is required to or decides to play from where he last played a stroke, (e.g. ball lost or out of bounds or unplayable), a player may accept transportation from anyone to and from the place he last played a stroke. (2) Suspension of play.

Caddies

The use of caddies is prohibited. *Penalty – Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.* The player must immediately discontinue use of any unauthorized caddy. *Penalty for continued breach – Disqualification.*

Note: Players in the Hoerman Cup and George Teale Trophy may use a cart driven by a volunteer to carry their clubs. The volunteer is not a caddy but an outside agency. The cart and everything in it (including the driver) is deemed to be equipment of the player whose ball is involved.

Distance Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Footwear

The use of footwear containing metal spikes is prohibited. *Penalty – Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.* The player must immediately discontinue use of the prohibited footwear. *Penalty for continued breach - Disqualification.*

Temporary Immoveable Obstructions

All tents, portable toilets and advertising signs on the course are Temporary Immoveable Obstructions. Local Rule prescribed in Appendix I applies. (Pages 131-134)
