To maintain the healthiness of the turf, most notably the overseeded fairways and greens, starting times will be moved back this year to avoid any further damage done by carts. We have kept our cutting heights up to absorb some of the wear and tear. We have also increased fertility application this past fall as well to the combat the issue.
