Job Duties: (include but not limited to)

Attend and make a report at all monthly, Board of Directors, meetings.

Must be a, hands on, boots on the ground, Superintendent.

Maintain all grounds and course maintenance and cart equipment.

Manage and participate in the equipment repair shop.

Keep accurate and detailed records of all equipment and maintenance on the course.

Hire, train, schedule, supervise and evaluate all personnel for the grounds department.

Supervise all planting, fertilizing and care of turf, plants, shrubs, trees on the entire course.

Prepare an annual budget for your department; take corrective action as necessary to ensure that budget goals are met.

Maintain drainage, irrigation and watering systems.

Maintain the course in proper playing condition.

Implement and enforce safety programs for employees in your department.

Maintain accurate work records for all personnel in your department.

Maintain strong and amicable communication ties with the course Golf Professional.

Maintain required and detailed records to insure that chemicals, petroleum and other controlled products are used, stored and disposed of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

Attend turf conferences, equipment shows, workshops and other educational programs to maintain a current knowledge of technical and turf innovations and changes that could affect the course operations and conditions.
