

Facility Overview Fox Run Golf Club is a semi-private golf club located in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Fox Run has seasonal golfing members, but the majority of the Club's business is from general public play. The course hosts numerous charity and corporate events culminating with the annual Marriott Corporate Golf Outing the first week in August. The Club hosts approximately 35,000 rounds per year. The course, built in 1985, is 6,234 yards from the championship tees. The 17 original push-up greens are Bentgrass and Poa Annua. The remaining 3 greens are USGA spec Bentgrass greens built in 1998. The current owner bought the property in 2005. The Club's founding principle is superior service delivering an exceptional product at a reasonable rate. The Club was voted #1 in Council Bluffs in 2015 and 2016.

Position Description The Golf Course Superintendent is a management level year-round position. The Superintendent must have good management and leadership skills. He/she should have reasonable computer skills, extensive agronomic experience and be an effective communicator. The ideal candidate will be "hands on", take great pride in his/her work and lead using a strong work ethic. This position would require the ability to perform within and manage a given budget. The superintendent will be asked to access the immediate needs of the course and also provide a vision for continuous course improvements for the upcoming years. He/she will report to the Course Owner directly.
