



Superintendent: Oak Hills Country Club

Course Description: Oak Hills is an 18-hole private Country Club. In 2006, the course underwent major improvements including: fumigation and re-grassing all greens to A-4 bent grass, conversion of all fairways and front 9 tees to L-93 bent grass, reconstruction of 2 green complexes, new bunkers, irrigation, cart path and drainage on the front 9. Fall of 2017, the back 9 renovation was completed including 5 new green complexes, new tees, irrigation, cart paths, creek restoration, pond expansions, Better Billy Bunker liners and angular sand in front and back 9 bunkers.

Job Description: The Superintendent will work closely with the Director of Grounds to satisfy all aspects of golf course management to include: employee hiring and training, equipment training and some minor maintenance, accuracy with application and tracking of chemical and fertilizer applications, effective water management, irrigation maintenance, tree and pond maintenance and much more. The successful candidate will be a positive and energetic Superintendent to assist the Director of Grounds to provide the membership the highest quality golf course conditions. The new Superintendent will be challenged on multiple levels to succeed and to advance in this profession.

Requirements: Graduate of a 2-year turfgrass certificate or a bachelor's degree in turfgrass science or related fields, 3 to 5 years as a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent. A current pesticide license and a valid driver's license is required.

Compensation: \$48,000 - \$60,000 salary based on experience, medical and dental benefits, 401K plan, paid personal time off, uniforms, golfing privileges, dues paid for state and national associations, local seminars and conventions.
