Golf Course Update By Jesse Metcalf, Course Superintendent

The golf course continues to hold up very well to the high volume of rounds. We look forward to more great weather and great course conditions for the remainder of the season.

As the season draws to a close, the Golf Maintenance Staff will begin preparing for our summer cultural practices. The work that is performed during the summer is essential in order to provide the course conditioning during the winter months. The 2021 closure dates are May 31-June 4, July 19-July 23, and September 7-September 11.

It has been brought to my attention that there is concern about having sand bottles on the tee boxes. The Golf and Greens Committees decided to remove the sand bottles. As part of our morning course set up a staff member goes through all of the tees on the course and adds sand to the divots. This ensures the divots are repaired properly and reduces excessive wear and tear on mowing equipment used on the tees due to sand not being leveled after being placed in a divot.

"CHECK-IN" PROCESS CHANGE

Effective **April 1**st, as part of our easing of covid restrictions, we will be returning to the in-person checkin process. All members and guests are **required** to check into the Golf Shop before their round. As we head into reciprocal season, we need to ensure accurate accounting of our golfers. Our goal is to make this a temporary process as we explore all capabilities of the new NorthStar IT system and streamline the check in process once it's implemented.
