We have enjoyed some very nice weather here at Bonita National in the first few months of the year. We hope the trend continues through the remainder of the season. The course has held up well to the traffic.

The staff has been working on restoring the shell paths to their original dimensions and replenishing the path material. It is a long and slow process and we anticipate completing this project by the end of the month.

We are working around the driving range lake, thinning the growth in order to facilitate retrieval of the range balls. By thinning the littoral plantings, we will allow better access for staff to safely collect range balls.

We do ask that everyone continue to follow the entry and exit stakes throughout the course. It seems to be working well to evenly distribute wear from cart traffic

Hole-In-One Program

It is not to late to join the Hole-In-One program for 2021. If you didn't enroll with your annual service agreement, contact the Pro Shop and they can help you. The program costs \$15* and pays out \$400 in credit on your BN master account for a Hole-in-One. This gives you the flexibility to spend as you wish; on your playing partners and friends, or keep it all for yourself as a credit toward your monthly bills!

Wait List Procedures

Many of our events fill up fast and require a wait list to be started. We will be doing all of our wait list through the Chelsea system going forward – this will allow us to form a timeline of when a player signed up on the wait list. The following is the procedure for the wait list:

- 1. Event will be posted on Chelsea.
- 2. Once event is filled on Chelsea The event will then be closed.
- 3. After the event is closed, we will send an email informing the membership that the event has been closed with instructions on how to sign up for the wait list.
- 4. The wait list will start at the time posted in the instructions.
- 5. The wait list will be open until 5 days prior to an event.
- 6. Any openings that occur in the event will be filled by the wait list created by Chelsea based on the order of signing up.

This process will allow all members to have an equal shot to sign up for the wait list. It also provides a time stamp of each sign up.

Did you know......

Bonita National has a local alligator rule on the golf course? With our beautiful location adjacent to preserve land we end up "sharing" our course with wildlife. While gators don't pose a threat if we leave them alone, we certainly don't wan t our members feeling that they need to retrieve their ball or hit a shot from a precarious position next to one of our prehistoric neighbors. For that reason, and for everyone's safety, we have the following rule:

If your ball comes to rest in a playable lie and is near an alligator, and you feel unsafe playing it from its position, you may drop (without penalty) in the nearest "safe" spot that most closely replicates the prior ball position.
