MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD OF **DIRECTORS**

- We would like everyone to be aware, if they are not already, that the third phase of the median strip renovation has been altered significantly in order to keep the cost down, to satisfy FPL easement requirements, and to satisfy commercial permits. The trees that are there will remain, but the shrubs underneath will be removed and replaced with flowering plants as used in the first and second phases of the plan. We do plan on lighting that section as well.
- Additionally, the Royal palms being used are what are called selfcleaning, which means that the fronds routinely fall off naturally. However, in this case, the dead or dying fronds are being held up by the wooden supports which are scheduled to remain in place for two years, so sometimes we have to call on our landscaper to remove them, and the landscaper, as always, has been very responsive.

Oak Trees and Shrubs

Please keep it in mind that oak tree also needs to be trimmed, with the canopy lifted to 8' over the sidewalk and 14' above the roadway. Also the viburnum hedges that run parallel to a street must be trimmed to no taller than 6' or wider than 4' and either flat on sides and on top or slightly rounded. Debris must be in bundles of no more than 4' long, weighing no more than 50 lbs. Debris is removed on Wednesdays.
