

STONEBROOK DINNERS INFORMATION

TIMES: Doors open at 5 P.M., and dinner begins at 5:30 P.M. Activities, entertainment, and clean-up must be finished by 8 P.M. when the Recreation Center closes.

SIGN UP: People who plan to attend dinners are asked to sign up in the binder in the Recreation Center hallway in advance for dinner or sign up online at www.stoneybrookhoa.com under the “Activities” heading. Tables, chairs, and table service will be set up according to the number of people who have signed up for the dinner. Setting up tables, chairs, and table service at the last minute for people who have not signed up is inconvenient and not easy. Please be considerate and sign up in advance.

FOOD: Dinner attendees need to bring their choice of a main entrée or a side dish such as a vegetable, salad, or dessert. The main entrée or the side dish should each serve at least 10 to 12 people. If Stoneybrook residents wish to bring guests, more food should be brought to appropriately cover the food eaten by their guests. If an attendee does not bring a main entrée or a side dish, it is requested that a donation of \$10/person (\$20/couple) be made, and it will be for one time only. Food must be brought after the one-time charge to future dinners. Please give the money as a donation (in addition to the optional purchase price of raffle tickets) to the person selling raffle tickets.

RAFFLE: A 50/50 raffle will be held to generate funds for the November Thanksgiving turkeys. The winner of the 50/50 is encouraged to keep the winnings.
