2021 SILVER OAK SENIOR MEN'S GOLF CLUB STANDING RULES

Standing rules govern the weekly operation of Silver Oak Senior Men's Golf Club (SOSMftC). These rules are adopted formally and put in writing so that a set policy is guaranteed.. They provide uniformity and continuity for the benefit of the membership. Standing rules differ from the BY-LAWS in that they may be changed or repealed at any club meeting by majority vote, and previous notice of said change need not be given.

SCORES & SCORECARDS

- ➤ On SOSMGC event days, cards shall be properly dated, signed and attested to prior to turning in to the designated representative immediately following play,-
- ➤ All disputes shall be addressed prior to turning in a scorecard. USGA rules govern all play unless modified by local rules.

HANDICAP

- ◆ The maximum allowable index for all SOSMGC events shall not exceed 36.4 as prescribed by the USGA Rules
- ◆ All SOSMGC scores are subject to the application of Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). If you do not have an established handicap, a maximum index of 36-4 is used to determine the most you may take on any hole.
- ◆ Members are eligible to use a provisional handicap assigned and approved by the handicap committee with the exception of SOSMGC major events (i.e.- Presidents Cup & Club Championship).
- If a handicap needs to be established, it's the responsibility of the member to do so in a fair and timely manner.

WEEKLY SOSMGC EVENTS

- Entry fees must be paid at time of check-in or the member is not eligible to participate in the event. However, the member may play golf with the group.
- ◆ A guest may play with a member, on a space available basis, in weekly events, but may not participate in the game and/or tournament.
- ◆ A player may win only one award per event (i-e. gross, net); however, a player may win more than one contest (i.e. closest to the hole, longest drive).
- Participation in a minimum of five events is required to play in SOSMGC Club Championship.

SOSMGC EVENT SIGN-UP

- Reservations for SOSMGC event play shall be made by 5:00pm on the Sunday before the event.
- Remaining tee times are released by Silver Oak Golf Course.
- ◆ Times are then on a space availability basis. Silver Oak Golf Course cancellation policy is in full effect.

Standing Rules continued:

HOLE IN ONE

- SOSMGC fees will include \$5.00 from each member for inclusion in the hole in one program.
- When a SOSMGC member scores a legitimate ace which is attested, during a SOSMGC event at Silver Oak Golf Course he shall receive up to \$100.00 towards celebration festivities.
- This is limited to the first two recorded hole in-ones' of the season.

GOLF ATTIRE

✔ Proper golf attire, including footwear, is required at all times. Silver Oak Golf Course is a soft spike facility.

MISCELLANEOUS

- GPS units are allowed provided the device measures distance only.
- It must not measure other conditions such as wind speed or direction, the slope of the ground or the temperature.
- The penalty for use of a non-conforming GPS unit is disqualification.
