A number of projects are underway to upgrade and freshen the Clubhouse. The goal of the House Committee is to get these projects completed in time for Spring as activities at the Club increase. The interior of the Clubhouse will be painted in the coming weeks and other projects such as refinishing the bar are also being scheduled and should be completed shortly. All of this work will be completed by WGC member volunteers. If you want to be a part of this revitalization effort and lend a hand, contact information is provided later in this article.

The Committee also has plans to update and freshen the entry to Clubhouse. WGC will be hiring a landscape designer to evaluate and make suggestions for landscape improvements such as plant removals/tree and bush trimming and then develop a refreshed planting scheme for the front entry. The pond near the door has become an ongoing maintenance issue and will replaced by a new, simpler water feature.

In an effort to minimize the costs, implementation of the landscape plan will be also done by WGC volunteers. This project is also scheduled to be complete before the start of the of the WGC "high season".

The House Committee is currently analyzing opportunities to maximize operating efficiencies and upgrade the restaurant menu, including increasing the quality and selection of food and drink items to be offered. These recommendations will be presented to the Board at the April meeting.

Many of you have requested that the fairway yardage markers be reinstalled. The red, white, and blue posts are very noticeable, but mowing around them is extremely time consuming, and the short-handed maintenance crew cannot spare that time. So, as an alternative solution, the Greens Chair has purchased high-visibility markers that will be placed in the middle of the fairways at 150 and 100 yards. They are designed so that the fairway reel mowers can pass over them instead of going around them (Thank you Pat Ford!).

Thanks to any and all volunteers - the work you do is a relief to our staff.


