## **Greens Report, From the Super**

As we come to the end of the summer golf season the crew is getting ready for greens aerification and fall leaf cleanup. No golfer I have ever met is excited about the greens being aerified in the last weeks of good golf weather in the PNW. However, aerification is an important part of maintaining healthy greens. The process relieves compaction from the season, allows more air exchange for the roots, and improves drainage. The addition of sand helps to reduce thatch and make a smoother, more consistent playing surface.

It is important that we do aerification when the weather is still nice. To properly move the sand into the holes created, we need nice sunny weather to dry out the sand. Warmer soil temperatures also help the greens recover quicker.

While the goal is to get the greens back as quickly as possible, rushing the process only damages the mowing equipment and removes sand from the green, defeating the purpose of applying the sand. Your patience and understanding during the recovery period will be rewarded with improved greens health, firmness and smoothness.
