



Dear Valued CRR golf members and customers,

It appears we will be back playing golf by tomorrow. And as we are all aware, golf is a fresh-air game and we want you to come and enjoy our wonderful golf course. However, it is critical for you to know that we value your safety and health as more important than anything else and for that we have established our own set of guidelines to protect you, other customers, AND our staff.

In addition to the items below that we are committed to, the CRR Board of Directors is requiring that for us to remain open and available for golf, EVERY golfer will be required to sign the attached waiver (COVID-19 WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION). To assist with this process, we are asking that you print it out and bring it in prior to playing your first round of golf. No one will be allowed to play until they have signed this waiver. It is absolutely critical that this be done or the golf course will be SHUT DOWN for play.

GOLF SHOP PROCEDURES & PROTOCOL

Until further notice we will be operating under the following policies and protocol:

- 1) The golf shop will be open for check-in purposes and restroom use only.
- 2) Only 4 people (1 foursome if that's the case) will be allowed in the shop at one time. Others will be asked (required) to wait outside and to maintain social distancing.
- 3) There will be no shotgun events until further notice; tee times will be booked in advance at 9 minute intervals with every third time blocked on busy days. Players are asked not to arrive more than 15 minutes in advance of their time and must maintain the required social distancing of 6 feet from others when waiting to register.
- 4) All staff will be gloved when handling cash and credit cards or regularly washing their hands thoroughly between transactions
- 5) We will be wiping down computer keyboards, counters, and door knobs constantly
- 6) Providing hand sanitizer on the counters
- 7) Cleaning the restroom facilities regularly with sanitizer and/or disinfectant
- 8) Wiping steering wheels and handrails and other touch points on the rental golf cars

GOLF & GOLF COURSE OPERATIONS

- 1) Golfers wishing to ride alone in a cart may do so. Carts MUST remain on the paths or driven in the rough only, no fairway traffic other than to cross to the other side, one or the other.
- 2) Bunker rakes will be removed and golfers are asked to smooth their prints as best possible with their foot or their golf club.
- 3) Ball washers have been removed.
- 4) Flagsticks must remain in the hole. Cup liners will be maintained at one inch above ground and a ball considered "holed" when having struck the liner. If a player inadvertently pulls the flagstick, he/she is asked to wipe it clean. If a ball inadvertently comes to rest in the hole, please remove it with a gloved hand...again, do NOT pull the flagstick.

At this time, golf may not seem quite the same, but to us your health and safety is our utmost concern. We greatly appreciate your support in any way you can help. We are all in this together and therefore all must do our part...allowing us to remain open and for golf to be a viable opportunity to get out and enjoy the fresh air.
