**THE RULES OF GOLF AS APPROVED BY THE USGA AND THE RSA GOVERN PLAY
EXCEPT WHEN MODIFIED BY THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES:**

1. **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE** — Any areas containing bark or wood chips are integral parts of the course. **WOOD CHIPS AND MULCH** are loose impediments.
2. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (e.g., **SPRINKLER HEADS**) **CLOSE TO THE PUTTING GREEN** — Local Rule as presented in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule F-5.
3. **DROPPING ZONES** — If a ball is in the penalty area on the below-mentioned holes, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
 - As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
 - Dropping Zones have been established on the following holes: 5 and 14; for a ball entering the red penalty area between the green stakes.
 - Holes 5 and 14 (DZ 5) — The red penalty area to the right of the putting green between the two green stakes.

CLUB RULES

1. No Pets on the course.
2. Keep pull carts off tees and a reasonable distance from the green.
3. Power carts use 90 degree rule, stay on paths where provided, and at least 25 feet from the green.
4. Each player must register in the golf shop and have their own set of clubs.
5. Groups larger than four not permitted without special permission from professional staff.
6. Slower groups must allow faster groups through, if there is an open hole in front. Permitting faster players to play through will make your own game more enjoyable.
7. All play must start on #1 Tee unless permission is obtained from the professional staff.
8. All players must abide by the LGCC Dress Code that is posted in the golf shop.
9. Soft spike shoes only.
10. Golfers assume sole responsibility for all property damage or personal injury caused by their shots.
11. Players use the course at their own risk.
