

We have been reviewing all the new guidelines and would like to share.

New Covid-19 Guidelines at White Mountain Country Club

- 1. Players must arrive or remain in their car until no more than **15** minutes prior to their tee-time,
- 2. Do not show up to the Club without a Tee-Time. Tee times can be made 7 days in advance by calling the Pro Shop at (603) 536-2227. Call the Pro Shop the day of your Tee-Time.
- 3. **Online Tee Times and Payment** can be made on the current day (Please see our Book Online Tee Time) Seniors (age 55+) and Ladies can play on Tuesdays and Wednesdays before 12pm at a discounted rate. Please call the Pro shop for Tee-times and Payment. Please use our Outside Walk-up Window when you have arrived for your tee-time.
- 4. Pro Shop will open for merchandise sales and limited check-in. Four people are allowed in the pro shop at a time and we ask you to wear a mask when inside.
- 5. Season Pass Holders can put money on account for cart fees, guest fees, merchandise, driving range and food service, the funds will be deducted as you use them.
- 6. League players must purchase their league round from our online store (instructions have been sent to all league members on payment and procedures)
- 7. Golf carts are now available for double riders. If you share a cart and are not from the same household, you should wear a mask when traveling together and within six-feet. Each cart will be sanitized before and after each use.
- 8. At the completion of your round. Return carts to designated area and discard trash.
- 9. Please leave when round is completed and no congregating in parking lot.
- 10. Personal clubs must be used; no rentals will be available.
- 11. Clubhouse will remain open for restroom availability only.
- 12. Food and Beverage Service will be available with curbside pickup and beverage cart service on the course when available. Snack Bar will open on June 15th for indoor seating.
- 13. All customers and staff must always maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others. Staff is required to wear face mask.
