ENTRY INFORMATION

Players will be notified of acceptance on or prior to June 1, 2024. No entries will be accepted without completed entry forms and payment and verified room reservation.

MEN'S ENTRY FEES

The Tournament entry fee includes the cost of green fees, golf carts, club storage, and practice range for the six days of the tournament play and one August 23 practice round. It also includes the welcome cocktail buffet, two awards dinners with receptions, western party with hosted bar and music, and early morning coffee and light breakfast for the six days of competition. Proof of handicap will be required at registration.

LADIES' ENTRY FEES

The Ladies entry fee includes continental breakfast for six days and a Saturday reception, fashion show, and luncheon. It also includes a putting contest, 2 excursions, a welcome cocktail buffet, two awards dinners with receptions, and a western party with a hosted bar and western music.

LADIES' GOLF ENTRY FEES

Ladies golf entry fee includes practice range, green fees and carts. Ladies may enter the Sunday scramble, and a new 2 day scramble, or both. Proof of handicap will be required at registration.

ENTRY DEADLINES — DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS May 1, 2024.

Due to our commitment to the venue, refunds of the entry fee will be made only for cancellations received **prior** to July 1, 2024. **No refunds can be issued after this date**. A \$500 administrative fee will be deducted for all cancellations regardless of date.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

On Saturday and Sunday play, August 24-25, 2024, the player will simultaneously compete in the International Team Competition (if an official member of the country's team), qualify for the 16-man Maytag Championship Flight and the 16-man Evans Flight, and participate in the President's Medal Competition – a stroke play event with awards to the 1st and 2nd low gross and 1st and 2nd low net winners in age groups (approximately 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79 and 80 and over). The French Super Senior Trophy will be awarded for the over 75 medalist.

The 16 players with the lowest qualifying gross scores will constitute the Maytag Championship Flight and the next 16 lowest qualifying gross scores will comprise the Evans flight, playing at scratch. The Committee may decide to play the third flight at scratch or with handicap, depending on the number of entries and handicap differentials. The remaining players will be placed in flights of 16 by handicap, beginning play on Tuesday, August 27 through Friday, August 30, 2024. These flights will play to 100% handicap differential. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make adjustments to handicaps. Spikeless or soft spike shoes must be worn.

A player new to the World Senior Golf Championships must have a handicap index of 20 or less. The maximum handicap that may be used in competition is 36. If a player has a handicap greater than 36, it will be adjusted from the beginning and he will be required to commence play at a 36.

The official men's practice round will be on Friday, August 23, 2024 at **7:30am in the Shotgun Start**, included in the entry for men. Practice for the ladies can be arranged, however, a practice round is NOT included in the entry fee. Tee times may be arranged for play on days

prior to August 23 through the World Senior office, space available at the World Senior Golf rate of \$99.00 per round. **Both men and women** need to contact Dianne Yelton via email at dianney.wsgf@gmail.com or call 513-477-7285.

Men and women can request extra tee times. Return the PRACTICE ROUND PARTNER REQUEST/EXTRA PRACTICE ROUND CARD or the ENTRY CARD FOR LADIES/GUESTS. Please indicate preferred times and pairings on the card(s) and every effort will be made to accommodate.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for the International Team Competition to teams (gross and net); to individuals; and to winners and runners-up (gross and net) in each age group in the President's Medal Competition. One Net Team and One Gross Team will be accepted from each country. Teams are comprised of 3-5 players each. A player may participate on either the Net or Gross Team, but not on both. The Net and Gross Teams must be declared to the World Senior Golf office prior to the flag raising ceremony. In the Match Play Competition, trophies will be awarded to the winner, runner-up, and the semi-finalists in each flight.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Rules of the United States Golf Association will govern play, with such amendments as may be announced by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee will interpret the rules and make all decisions. Match play pairings will be made in accordance with U.S.G.A. numerical draw, scratch flights.

The Tournament Committee regards pace of play as a very important aspect of an enjoyable and successful tournament and will be monitoring play to ensure that play progresses at a reasonable and satisfactory pace of approximately four and ½ hours per round. PLAYING GROUPS THAT FALL OUT OF POSITION WILL BE WARNED, AND IF THE GROUP DOES NOT RESPOND TO THE WARNING, SANCTIONS MAY BE IMPOSED.

ROOM RESERVATIONS

ALL CONTESTANTS MUST BE REGISTERED GUESTS OF THE HYATT REGENCY TAMAYA RESORT, SANTA ANA PUEBLO, NEW MEXICO. <u>All room reservations and all changes must be made by</u> <u>participants</u>. You will not be officially registered for the tournament until you make your room reservation. You will see room reservation information on a card with your invitation. If you participated at Tamaya, in 2023, then you will be given priority registration for the tournament at 2024, but you must return your tournament entry card and have your room reservation by April 1. *If you did not participate at Tamaya, in 2023, <u>please wait until April 2</u> to reserve your room.*

The Resort may not be able to accommodate the contestant if he arrives on a date other than that specified. The Resort reserves the right to levy an appropriate charge to any hotel guest who departs earlier than the departure date on their hotel reservation. ALL room costs for a contestant including failure to arrive or depart as indicated on their reservation with the hotel will be charged to the contestant's credit card on file. If you withdraw from the tournament, please remember to cancel your room reservation.

• ACCEPTANCE: You are officially accepted into the tournament when you have returned your ENTRY CARD, your PRACTICE ROUND PARTNER REQUEST AND EXTRA PRACTICE REQUEST CARD, your ENTRY CARD FOR LADIES/GUESTS, (if applicable), you have paid your entry fees, and you have made your room reservation.

• **DEADLINES for entry and cancellations:** You must enter the tournament by May 1, 2024. Due to our commitment to the tournament venue and purchases of awards, gifts, etc., **REFUNDS CAN BE MADE ONLY FOR CANCELLATIONS RECEIVED BY JULY 1,2024.** A \$500 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE WILL BE DEDUCTED FOR ALL CANCELLATIONS

• **PRACTICE ROUND:** The Men's fees include a practice round on Friday, August 23. Lady golfers may request an extra practice on the ENTRY CARD FOR LADIES/GUESTS, but ladies will have to pay for the round in the Pro Shop. Men may request extra practice rounds on the **PRACTICE ROUND REQUEST/EXTRA PRACTICE ROUND REQUEST CARD** that is sent in with the entry, also paid in the Pro Shop.

• **ROOM RESERVATIONS:** You must make your own room reservation. The information is on a separate card. IF YOU WITHDRAW FROM THE TOURNAMENT, PLEASE REMEMBER TO ALSO CANCEL YOUR ROOM RESERVATION.

• **REGISTRATION:** You must register between 12:00pm and 6:00pm, on Thursday, August 22. Players that cannot register by this time must meet with Darrell Williams prior to teeing off on Friday. REQUIRED CHECKLIST FOR OFFICIAL ENTRY INTO THE TOURNAMENT

- Return ENTRY CARD to Dianne Yelton. Make sure that you and your wife/guest sign the card.
- Return the NEW PRACTICE ROUND PARTNER REQUEST/EXTRA PRACTICE ROUND REQUEST CARD to Dianne Yelton. (This is a new card used to replace a similar one that previously was in the invitation.)
- Return the NEW ENTRY CARD FOR LADIES AND/OR GUESTS to Dianne Yelton.
- □ USA Players Send a check for your entry to Dianne Yelton.
- □ Make Room Reservation, using the group code or the online link (Please use the group code, if you call, or the link if you reserve your room online.) You don't need to send a confirmation to Dianne.
- □ International Players: Pay your bill NEW After you email your entry card, you will receive an invoice for the amount that you owe for your entry. The invoice will come from invoice@authorize.net. Click on the link, enter your credit card information, and click "Send". Once you pay, you will receive a digital receipt confirming payment. This process is done through Chase Bank and is very secure. Authorize.net is a Visa Owned company so the transactions are encrypted end to end.
