Court Construction!

Make your Reservations!

We have started construction to post-tension overlay to Courts 2,3,4 & 5 so we will no longer have cracks. The project entails taking fencing down, forming, laying rebar, and pouring a 5" concrete cap over the existing surface. After a 28-day curing period the courts will be surfaced, lines painted and fences raised 5". Total time will be approximately 60 days. After completion of Cts.2-5, we will post-tension cap Courts 9 & 10 and simply resurface courts 7 & 8. This will take another 60 days so by the end of the year, we will have 6 new courts, plus 2 resurfaced, making Bentwood a premier tennis facility! *During this time we will be down to eight courts so please, make your reservations.*

Easy Carnitas with Beer & Pepper Jelly

Carnitas are an easy way to serve a crowd. A traditional two-part cooking process (braising and then browning the pork) results in an incredibly tender texture and rich, meaty flavor. In this recipe, the pork is cooked in beer and then the shredded meat is tossed in a spicy sweet pepper jelly. Serve in hot corn tortillas topped with shredded cabbage and a squeeze of lime.

Ingredients:

2 1/2 pound boneless pork shoulder, cut into 2-inch cubes, 2 (12-ounce) bottles lager, 1 onion, chopped, 3 cloves garlic, crushed, 1 cinnamon stick, Zest of 1 orange, removed in wide strips with a vegetable peeler, 3 fresh bay leaves, 1 1/2 teaspoon coarse sea salt, 3 tablespoons pepper jelly.

Method:

Combine pork, beer, onion, garlic, cinnamon stick, orange zest, bay leaves and salt in a large deep skillet or Dutch oven. Liquid should just barely cover meat (it doesn't need to be completely submerged); add water if necessary. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and simmer, stirring occasionally, until all liquid has evaporated, 1 1/2 to 2 hours. Sear meat in the dry skillet, turning occasionally, until browned and crispy on the edges, about 5 minutes. Remove from heat. When meat is cool enough to handle, remove cinnamon stick, orange zest and bay leaves and discard. Use a fork to shred meat. Stir in pepper jelly until combined.

Pepper Jelly Ingredients

2 1/2 cups finely chopped red bell peppers, 1 1/4 cups finely chopped green bell peppers, 1/4 cup finely chopped jalapeno peppers, 1 cup apple cider vinegar, 1 (1.75 ounce) package powdered pectin, 5 cups white sugar

Directions: Sterilize 6 (8 ounce) canning jars and lids according to manufacturer's instructions. Heat water in a hot water canner.

Place red bell peppers, green bell peppers, and jalapeno peppers in a large saucepan over high heat. Mix in vinegar and fruit pectin. Stirring constantly, bring mixture to a full rolling boil. Quickly stir in sugar. Return to full rolling boil, and boil exactly 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat, and skim off any foam.

Quickly ladle jelly into sterile jars, filling to within 1/4 inch of the tops. Cover with flat lids, and screw on bands tightly.

Place jars in rack, and slowly lower jars into canner. The water should cover the jars completely, and should be hot but not boiling.

Bring water to a boil, and process for 5 minutes.


