Bentwood Tennis 2016 Junior Lesson Programming

JR. TENNIS LESSONS with QuickStart!

Junior Tennis Lessons are designed for the beginner to intermediate-level junior tennis players ages 5-12 years. Participants can expect to learn basic stroke mechanics, coordination skills, keeping score, match-play, etc. This group teaches the FUNdamentals while keeping the kids entertained with fun and games. We use the USTA's popular QuickStart curriculum which scales down the court and uses pressure-less balls so kids can actually learn what it means to play tennis! Groups are structured by the ball type/court size, red ball, orange ball and green dot ball to coincide with the USTA Quickstart program. This better develops the players and during the groups they will be asked at time to be mentors to the younger players and get the opportunity to be challenged by the older players/ball type.

Court Construction! Make your Reservations!

We have started construction to post-tension overlay to Courts 2,3,4 & 5 so we will no longer have cracks. The project entails taking fencing down, forming, laying rebar, and pouring a 5" concrete cap over the existing surface. After a 28-day curing period the courts will be surfaced, lines painted and fences raised 5". Total time will be approximately 60 days. After completion of Cts.2-5, we will post-tension cap Courts 9 & 10 and simply resurface courts 7 & 8. This will take another 60 days so by the end of the year, we will have 6 new courts, plus 2 resurfaced, making Bentwood a premier tennis facility! *During this time we will be down to eight courts so please, make your reservations.*

Chef Chad's Recipe of the Month

For a tasty summer treat that's sure to please any crowd, try this Old Fashioned Pineapple Upside Down Cake!

Here's what you will need: 4 eggs, 1/2 cup of butter, 1 cup packed light brown sugar, 1 (20 ounce) can sliced pineapples, 10 maraschino cherries, halved, 1 cup sifted flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1 cup white sugar, 1 tablespoon melted butter, 1 teaspoon almond extract.

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. In a 10 inch heavy skillet with a heat resistant handle (I use a cast iron skillet), melt 1/2 cup of butter on very low heat. Remove from heat, and sprinkle brown sugar evenly over pan. Arrange pineapple slices to cover bottom of skillet.

Distribute cherries around pineapple; set aside. Sift together flour, baking powder, and salt. Separate the eggs into two bowls. In a large bowl, beat egg whites just until soft peaks form. Add granulated sugar gradually, beating well after each addition. Beat until medium stiff peaks form. In a small bowl, beat egg yolks at high speed until very thick and yellow. With a wire whisk or rubber scraper, using an over and under motion, gently fold egg yolks and flour mixture into whites until blended. Fold in 1 tablespoon melted butter and almond extract. Spread batter evenly over pineapple in skillet. Bake until surface springs back when gently pressed with fingertip and a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. About 30 to 35 minutes. Loosen the edges of the cake with table knife. Cool the cake for 5 minutes before inverting onto serving plate.

GRANDKIDS, BABY SITTERS, & GUESTS

Guests - Daily guests must check in with the Pool Manager upon arrival. Adult children of members are considered guests. Guest Fee is \$10+ per person per day billed to host member. Guests 4 & Under, complimentary. Non-members are allowed to be guests at the pool twice monthly.

Baby Sitters - Register your babysitter with the Receptionist in the Clubhouse to receive your complimentary pool pass. They must provide a photo ID. Babysitters must be with your children to use Bentwood facilities.

Grandkids - Complimentary accompanied passes are available from the Receptionist for your 'out of town' grandkids. 'In town' passes may be purchased for accompanied or unaccompanied grandkids.

Pricing is based on quantity.

All children ages 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult or a guardian 14 years of age or older.

Pool News

Bentwood Country Club Pool Rules & Regulations

- All Members, family members and guests must register upon entry to the pool area. A member must accompany each guest. Applicable guest charges will be applied to the member's charge account.
- Lifeguards will be present during operating hours; however, the Club assumes no liability for the safety of anyone using the pool or its facilities. The lifeguards will be in charge of the pool area with the authority to enforce all rules including limiting activities of anyone disturbing others. Under no circumstances is the pool to be used unless a Club lifeguard is present and on duty.
- The Pool will be closed and cleared for a ten (10) minute safety break/adult swim during the following hours...Tuesday – Saturday; 12n, 2:00pm, 4:00pm, 6:00pm and Sunday; 3:00pm and 6:00pm. This is a good time to head to the restroom and Pool Cabana or give the adults a chance to play volleyball! Don't forget to re-apply sunscreen!
- Only proper swim attire will be permitted at the Pool. Cut-offs, thongs and similar dress will not be allowed. Public display of affection will not be allowed.
- Running, roughness, foul language will not be tolerated.
- Adults have priority in the Tanning Deck.
- Be respectful of younger children in the Kiddie Pool and around the volleyball/basketball area.
- All infants and toddlers who are not 'potty trained' are required to wear swim diapers and/or rubber pants in the Pool at all times.
- Food and drinks purchased from Bentwood Country Club are the only products that may be consumed on Club property. No outside food, drinks, cups or coolers. Glass containers will not be allowed in the pool area.

- Children ages nine (9) and under are not allowed in the pool area without an adult or guardian fourteen (14) years of age or older. The responsible adult or guardian must be present in the pool area at all times and must register at the Pool Desk as the designated guardian of the identified children. Member children ages eight (8) and up will be allowed without an adult or guardian if they pass a swim test administered by a lifeguard or Pool Manager. The swimmer must be able to easily swim the entire length of the BCC pool and tread in deep water for at least ninety seconds.
- Persons will not be permitted in the pool area if they have a cold, cough, fever, skin rash, inflamed eyes or infection of any kind.
- Hard balls (such as tennis, soccer, baseball, etc) and large flotation devices will not be allowed in the pool. Water Balls Only! These balls may be checked out with a lifeguard and returned when finished.
- Diving is only allowed in designated areas.
- Pets are not allowed in the Pool area.
- Smoking is not allowed in the Pool area.
- A 'Lost and Found' will be located at the Pool Desk during the swim season. If items are not claimed within two weeks they will be disposed of.
- Lifeguards have the authority to enforce all pool rules. Patrons who repeatedly violate the rules may be ejected by a Lifeguard or the Pool Manager.
- Management, Pool Manager or Lead Lifeguard are authorized to close the Pool when necessary for weather, safety or maintenance reasons.
