- LPGA International believes that all groups should maintain the spacing/timing with the group in front of them. Doing so will eliminate all gaps on the course and ensure that all players play in a timely manner.
- Please be ready to make a shot when it is your turn to play. Ready Golf is highly encouraged.
- Please remember to sand all divots, repair all ball marks, and rake all bunkers.
- Dress code is strictly enforced for all Members and Guests.

Local Rules

- Play is governed by USGA Rules of Golf except where modified by local rules.
- The Golf Professional Staff has the full authority and support of the Board of Governors to maintain the rules and pace of play.
- All water hazards and wetlands are played as lateral water hazards.

Golf Cart Rules

- Golf Carts shall not be used without proper assignment and registration in the Pro Shop.
- Each operator of a golf cart must be at least sixteen years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- Please obey all golf course signs.
- Always use cart paths where provided, especially near tees and greens.
- Unless otherwise posted, the 90° cart rule will always be in effect. Drive to your ball, cross directly to it. After playing your shot, leave the fairway by the shortest means possible.

Weather

Players expressly assume all risk of injury while on the golf course due to lightning or other adverse weather. Players should not rely on the accuracy, reliability or adequacy of any storm systems implemented by the Club.
