Turf Talk December 19, 2019

Hard to believe 2020 is here already! Time indeed does fly when you're having fun.

Our winter project list is well underway. To date we have cleared brush around ponds on holes 5 and 12. Additionally fallen trees by the 11th fairway and 12th tee have been removed. Water cooler stations and trash can receptacles have been moved to the shop for repair and repainting. Tee marker painting is also underway and should be finished shortly.



Looking forward to spring, I have had discussions with a few members regarding a **"Member Volunteer Day"** on the course. We are still formulating some projects that

would be suitable for our members to assist with. We will roll this program out as we move into warmer spring weather. Stay tuned for further details.

The driving range tee has been closed for the season to ensure improved turf coverage for next spring. Please use the mats that we have been purchasing throughout the year. The turf portion of the tee will reopen in March. On that note, please adhere to cart path only directives when in place.

Cart damage suffered now, will linger until next spring, as our turf is dormant and will not recover. We have recently been experiencing some vandalism on the course, particularly the putting greens. A police report was filed last week in response to damage incurred on greens 4 and 7.
