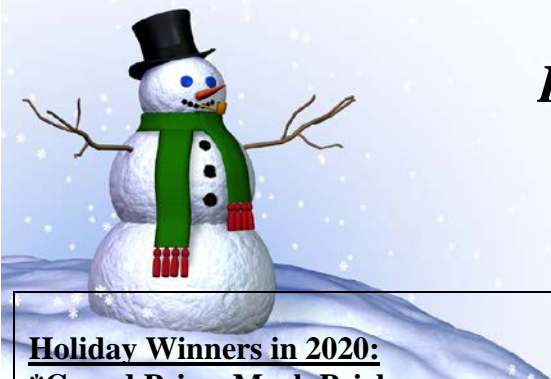

TURF TALK

Year to date we have received in excess of 63 inches of rain. This total is 20 inches above our annual average! Obviously this has presented some challenges to our maintenance efforts. Saturated soils have resulted in many cart path only days, and standing water in bunkers and turf areas.

This time of year the turf doesn't absorb as much water when compared to actively growing turf during the summer. Please be vigilant as you exit the cart paths, as many wet areas still exist, even as we allow the 90 degree rule. Winter projects continue, as we trim native areas throughout the course to improve playability. So far areas on holes; 2,3,5,7 and 10 have been completed. Fortunately the bulk of the leaves have been removed, with a few pesky areas remaining. Heavy play has also resulted in many unrepaired ball marks. Please repair them during your round as they are very slow to heal this time of year as turf growth diminishes.

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank our loyal members for their support this year, and to wish everyone a safe and healthy holiday season!
