Turf Talk January 18, 2020

Hope everyone is enjoying a nice new year so far! Temperatures have been above average for the most part this month allowing for some great winter golf. The greens have held their color well and we continue occasional mowing to keep them smooth and true.

Winter projects are progressing well. A new cap was installed on the wall behind the bag drop at the cart staging area by the golf shop. This consisted of adding pressure treated 2X10 planks that will be painted in the spring when the wood cures. Tee marker painting has been completed, and only two ball washers remain to be refurbished. You may have also noticed the new roof on the clubhouse, cart barn and pump station. Currently we are painting the pump station and adding new trim. When completed it will match the paint scheme on the water coolers in gray and blue.

Tree trimming continues with 3 tee and 4 green areas completed recently. Tree control is important because it allows for improved air movement, which helps lessen disease potential. Shade can also be a problem. It inhibits sunlight to the surface, prolongs leaf moisture, diminishes photosynthesis and generally leads to less healthy turf. We look forward to seeing you on the course during the winter months.
