Turf Talk January 19, 2023

The wet, above average temperatures thus far this winter continues. A peek at the long range forecast suggests that this trend may persist, at least in the short term. This has allowed us to continue our native area trimming efforts unabated. Most of the trimming has been completed with the exception of Lakes 10 and 13.

When finished; we will turn our focus to bunker renovation. We plan to improve the playability of the most strategic bunkers by repairing drainage and installing additional sand. You will recall that last year we converted several sand bunkers to zoysia grass in select areas. We will continue incremental improvement of the bunkers in order to improve the overall playability of the course.



Grassy areas that were added last season in order to enhance the facility for wildlife habitation will also be cut this winter in order to reduce weeds and improve aesthetics. Let's see if our mild weather continues. In the meantime we look forward to seeing you on the course.
