Turf Talk

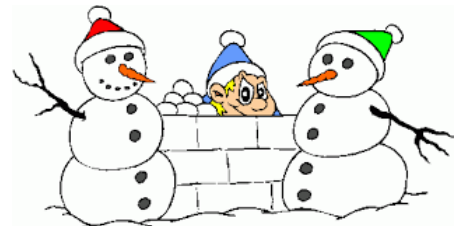
We received measurable snow fall in mid - January, forcing our first closure in almost 2 years!

Meanwhile, we continue another busy off season on the course with ongoing bunker renovations. Thus far bunkers on holes 9 and 17 have been completed. Next are greenside bunkers on holes 1 and 2. This work will continue into the spring as we strive to improve our overall bunker conditioning throughout the facility.

Tee marker painting continues and should be completed in the next couple of weeks. Annual native area trimming is also underway as we are nearing the completion of pond banks. We will strive to clear as many strategic areas as possible to improve the playability and aesthetic appeal of each hole. Irrigation will be a priority when we recharge our system in a few weeks. Several leaks will be repaired prior to the growing season to more effectively water our turf in 2024.

Warmer weather is on the horizon as we count down the days until spring. Looking forward to seeing you often in 2024!
