please call or sign up outside the Proshop.

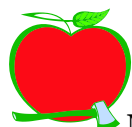

Now that we are heading into the Spring season, we will be removing all cart covers over the next few weeks. Please make arrangements to pick up your cart cover by calling the pro shop or stopping by the club.

### Gift Certificates

As we move into the golf season, many of you will play in a member or outside tournament here at Lee's Hill. With these tournaments, **Gift Certificates** are given as prizes. These gift certificates all have an expiration date on them that is 6 months from the date of the tournament. It is extremely important that you are aware of the expiration date and use this certificate before it expires. Once the expiration date passes, the system purges the gift certificate and there is no way to reinstate it.

### TURF TALK

Cold wet weather has persisted into 2019. At least the Groundhog has predicted an early spring this year! We have been making progress on our winter project list.

Thus far we have refurbished all water cooler stations and trash cans, repaired and repainted two of three Lee's Hill signs in the parking lot area and re painted all tee markers. Next up we will be painting the ball washers, finishing the ornamental grass trimming at tee stations and additional tree removal in select areas. Currently we are clearing trees in the proximity of #15 green to allow better air circulation and allow more sunlight for improved turf quality. We have also located a Mattaway seeder which will allow us to slit seed thin areas on greens prior to spring. This will help to facilitate a quicker, more dense recovery this season. Greens have also been sprayed recently as a preventative measure to alleviate winter disease pressure.

Hopefully our rodent friend is correct in his prognostication, bringing warmer and drier spring weather to our wet, cold region.
