TURF TALK



Winter weather has dominated this past month. Seasonal temperatures with snowfall totals that have eclipsed the past several years combined, has been the story. As of this writing, the course has received 14 inches of snow and has been closed for a total of 10 days.

We have been able to stay busy on the course by trimming wooded and native areas throughout the property. Recently completed areas include; 1 tee, 2 tee, 3 tee and 4 green, 9 green, 10 tee, 12 tee and 15 green. These seasonal trimming efforts will help to improve aesthetics, as well as improving turf conditions with enhanced sunlight and air movement to the turf surface. Our Audubon certification efforts continue to progress. We have completed the first two phases, Environmental Planning and Wildlife and Habitat Management. We are currently assessing our need for bird feeders and nest boxes to attract additional wildlife. When finalized, we will be soliciting volunteers to assist us in our efforts. Also a couple of butterfly/hummingbird gardens will be planted on the course that will provide additional volunteer opportunities.

On that note, if anyone knows of a school group or other organization that would be interested in partnering with us in our efforts, please let us know. On a side note, the entire cart fleet has undergone winter maintenance to ensure optimum performance next season. Hang in there, warmer weather is right around the corner!
