"The More You Know"

Did you know pizza Margherita was named after the Queen of Italy?

Like with so many centuries-old foods, the origins of pizza Margherita are surrounded by legends. A popular one says that the pizza Margherita was invented by Raffaele Esposito at Pizzeria Brandi in Naples in 1889 to celebrate the unification of Italy. A plaque by the entrance of Pizzeria Brandi attests to this.

It is also believed the three toppings – basil, mozzarella, and tomato – represent the colors of the Italian flag and that Esposito named this pizza after Queen Margherita of Savoy.

Others believe the name comes from the Italian word for daisy, Margherita, since the mozzarella slices on the pizza are arranged like the petals of this flower. I, however, believe this is one of the most delicious pizzas available today no matter how you slice it!

Dress Code Beginning April 1st

Beginning April 1st the no denim policy will be enforced. Proper attire is required at all times while on property. While on the golf course, "soft spikes" or non metal spikes must be worn at all times. All shirts must have a collar. Neither jeans nor denim pants are allowed at any time. Your cooperation and support is appreciated.

Turf Talk

Winter maintenance on the course continues. We have many of the native areas trimmed, with the exception of 10,18 lake bank which will be completed shortly. Cooler stands have been refurbished and are being reinstalled throughout the course. Bunker sand installation continues. We plan to complete this phase of the project by the end of April.

Pre emergent weed control will be applied to fairways this month in an effort to control goose and crabgrass populations this summer. The pot holes in the Clubhouse parking lot have been filled and compacted. This program will be ongoing as needed to help maintain the integrity of the asphalt. The drains around the parking lot have also been cleared in an attempt to keep the area drier and minimize the potential for pothole formation.

Finally our greens aeration has been scheduled for Monday March 18th. We will be contracting a vertidrain again this spring to help facilitate enhanced root growth. Deep rooting generally leads to a healthier plant that can better withstand the rigorous summer conditions that are common in our area during the summer months. Looking forward to seeing you on the course this spring!
