# TURF TALK

Early in the month it looked as if we were going to have an early spring as temperatures rose and everything began to show some life. Fairways began to green-up and plants started to bloom. Unfortunately that was short lived and we experienced much cooler weather, several frosty mornings and many windy days. This of course is not good for turf and plant materials, however I think they were just set back and not critically damaged. April is almost here, and I believe we will be just fine with some sunshine and heat.

Growth regulators were applied on the greens this past month to suppress seedhead formation by the poa annua turf. These chemicals combined with the cold temperatures caused the greens to lose some of their green color but were effective at decreasing the flowering so far. If seedheads are produced, the plant is forced to use any carbohydrates in its reserves and can cause stress due to a weaker system, in addition to creating a bumpy surface. Aeration of greens will take place during the last week of March. We are scheduled for that Monday a nd Tuesday but the forecast of rain makes me think it will take longer. This practice is crucial to their health and survival through the upcoming summer. In addition to the sand, organic fertilizer and other amendments will be brushed into the holes to aid in air space, water infiltration, and root growth.

It won't be long before fairways and tees begin to start growing. Once they break dormancy we will fertilize to push growth and recovery. A pre-emergent herbicide has already been sprayed on all bermuda, except the rough which will be completed soon. Tees will be aerated in April and fairways in May.

I would like to welcome and introduce a new key member of our maintenance staff. Mr. Shawn Noonan has joined the team as the Equipment Manager/Assistant Superintendent. Shawn brings years of experience in this business and will keep our machines operable and help on the course as needed. I am very excited about this addition and all that he will contribute to our success. Thank you,
