90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)

At this time of the year, it is **<u>extremely important</u>** to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. We are noticing an abundance of wear in these areas and we want to avoid putting up ropes/signs in order to keep carts from damaging the turf further. Your help and attention to this matter is most appreciated

Turf Talk March 2019

Spring has sprung! Here's hoping for a more normal weather pattern than we have experienced recently. Thus far in 2019 we are well above our average precipitation totals at 14". On the course we are currently wrapping up our Ronstar application on fairways and tees. This material is a pre emergent herbicide that will greatly reduce our grassy weed population this season.

We have also completed seeding thin areas on greens with a slit seeder. This machine cuts shallow grooves in the green surface and deposits seeds at a depth of a quarter inch. The increase in turf population will result in a quicker recovery as we move into spring growing weather. Tree trimming continues throughout the course, as does our winter project list. Next up will be pressure washing the clubhouse and tent deck area. When this is completed, we will begin our seasonal clubhouse landscape cleanup.

Landscaping beds on the course will also be cleaned up and re mulched. As the weather breaks, we look forward to seeing you often on the course! John Burns, GC Superintendent
