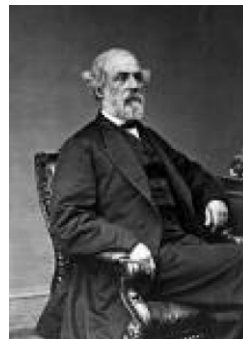

### May & June

We would like to encourage you to review the enclosed calendar, review the on line calendar and become familiar with the events that are taking place in the busiest part of the season, May and June. We are monitoring the tee sheet very closely and free up tee times as the information becomes available to us.

### 90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)

At this time of the year, it is **extremely important** to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. We are noticing an abundance of wear in these areas and we want to avoid putting up ropes/signs in order to keep carts from damaging the turf further. Your help and attention to this matter is most appreciated

The golf season is here and we are all excited. With it comes all the beauty that is a golf course! While we do appreciate our many joggers, walkers, dog walkers and site seer, we ask that they would use the community paths instead of the golf course cart paths.

### TURF TALK

We completed greens aerification earlier in the month. This consisted of two separate aerations. The initial being performed by a soil reliever that utilized a half inch diameter solid tine that penetrated the surface to a depth of 5 inches. The second procedure involved our Toro Pro Core aerator. We used quarter inch hollow tines that pulled cores and deposited them on the surface. The cores were blown off and the greens toppedressed with sand and fertilized.

Periodic aerations improve turf rooting, increase water percolation and oxygen levels and improves mineral uptake resulting in improved turf conditions. We appreciate your patience as the greens continue to improve from last year. Increased soil temperatures will also help to promote growth and speed the healing process. Thin areas on greens will continue to be spot seeded and toppedressed to facilitate recovery.

Our initial course mowing was completed mid month, which consisted of rough, fairway, tee and collar mowing. Greens are currently being mowed 4-5 days per week and rolled on the non mow days to ensure more consistent conditions. Landscape beds have been sprayed with pre and post emergent herbicide and will be mulched soon. Looking forward to seeing you on the course this spring!
