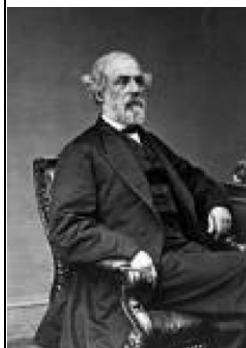

**90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)**

At this time of the year, it is **extremely important** to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. We are noticing an abundance of wear in these areas and we want to avoid putting up ropes/signs in order to keep carts from damaging the turf further. Your help and attention to this matter is most appreciated

**TURF TALK**

We would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for observing the social distance guidelines on the course. Your compliance will allow golf to continue to be played in the Commonwealth. We decided to place the putting green cups to regulation depth, due to the fact that they had a tendency to blow over in high winds. They remain touch free with the addition of a pool noodle installed around the flagstick.

Progress continues to be made on the course with bunker sand replenishment, greens aeration and topdressing, and the application of pre-emergent herbicides throughout the property. Course fertilization is set for the end of the month to take advantage of optimal turf growing weather. Greens will also be vertical mowed and additional topdressing applied to ensure smooth playing conditions.

You've probably also noticed that the parking lot has been recently striped and broken flag pole re installed. We hope this addition finds everyone healthy, Stay Well!
