90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)

At this time of the year, it is <u>extremely important</u> to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. We are noticing an abundance of wear in these areas and we want to avoid putting up ropes/signs in order to keep carts from damaging the turf further. Your help and attention to this matter is most appreciated

TURF TALK

Warmer weather and beneficial rainfall are starting to green up our bermudagrass fairways and tees. We have aerated the tees and plan on knocking out the fairways in the next couple of weeks. Bare areas in fairways and roughs have been tilled with our pulverizer in order to help facilitate new growth in these spots.

Fertilization will follow to assure that the fairways grow through some of the spring dead spot issues that we experienced last winter. Fortunately the damage was not overly severe, lessening our recovery time. Greens continue to progress nicely, with a light vertical mowing being performed to clean up any remaining seedheads.

You will notice several new birdhouses on the course. Thanks again Jim! Hopefully, these will attract a variety




of new tenants to the facility and add to the course's natural beauty. Finally in an attempt to add more corridors for wildlife, we are installing approximately 5 acres of outer rough that will be allowed to grow to their natural state. These are perimeter areas and will have little to no impact on course playability. These natural areas will be mowed in the offseason to

control weed and tree growth. With improving weather we look forward to seeing you often this season!
