### **TURF TALK**

It's almost June and we are still waiting on some heat and sunshine to push growth on our bermudagrass. May has been wet, cool, and dreary which is good for the weeds, but not the turf. Tees and fairways still need to fill in a little, but overall are in good shape. The rough, particularly around greens however, really needs to start growing more actively to get complete coverage. We have aerated, topdressed, and fertilized these weak spots but without sunshine, recovery is much slower than we would like. While there are very few weeds in the fairways and tees, the rough contains quite a bit of poa annua. We are in the process of spraying to kill the weeds, and warmer temperatures will also help push them out.

The greens, on the other hand, are enjoying the cool spring. Heavy rains early in the month made it apparent that they were not draining below four inches very well so we had them deep tine aerated on the 17<sup>th</sup>. I hated to disrupt the surfaces at this time because they were looking and rolling nice, but for the long term health I knew it was important. It took about a week to heal from aeration and they now stand a much better chance of surviving the summer. Greens that do not drain well are susceptible to many diseases and damage once hot and humid conditions arrive. We soon will verticut the greens for a third time this spring and apply a light sand topdressing to smooth out.

### **90 Degree Cart Rule: Important (please read)**



At this time of the year, it is extremely important to enter the fairways at 90 degrees to the ball from the path in order to help not wear out the turf at the beginning of each fairway once leaving the tee box. Your help and attention to this matter is most appreciated.
