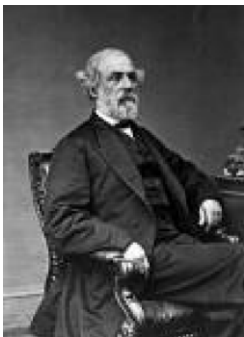

Club Championship – October this year!

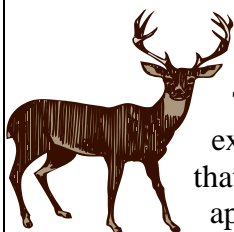

TURF TALK

Turf Talk June 2020

We have been extremely busy on the course getting ready for the summer season. Fertilizer has been applied on greens, tees, fairways and roughs to take advantage of the upcoming warmer weather. Bunker sand installation is ongoing with a dozen bunkers being replenished thus far.

Recently purchased mulch is being added to tree rings and flower beds at the clubhouse and on the course. We have also started aerating tees and fairways to alleviate soil compaction and optimize growth this season. Our afternoon greens watering will be in effect as warranted this summer to minimize heat damage by controlling canopy temperatures. Both irrigation heads and hoses will be used. This practice, known as syringing, helps to relieve turf stress, regulate temperatures and conserve plant available moisture.

Thank you in advance for your patience, as we make our rounds during the afternoon. We hope everyone has stayed healthy thus far and would like to thank you again for your adherence to social distancing guidelines. We look forward to seeing you on the course!
