TURF TALK

Warm dry weather has dominated the area the past several weeks. The fairways were just emerging from dormancy when this dry spell set in. During this time, it is extremely important to adhere to the 90 degree cart rule. This practice, if adhered to, will help to mitigate cart traffic impacts on drought dormant fairways. Please utilize the cart path until you come to where your ball is located and proceed in a straight line to its location. After hitting your shot please proceed straight back to the path and continue the process. The mistake people make is they drive directly to their ball, riding the fairway the entire time. This adds substantial traffic to



drought stressed fairways and will delay turf recovery once we do receive rainfall. Thanks for your cooperation in this matter.

It is time once again for the invasion of the

Cicadas. This is also the year that brood X, red eyed Cicadas emerge for the first time in 17 years. Conditions have been favorable for a good crop of these insects. Have no fear, they are generally harmless and make a distinctive sound when mating.
