TURF TALK

The golf course continued to receive a good amount of rainfall through June, keeping us busy with mowing and other maintenance. The bermudagrass is doing very well as the fairways, tees, and rough have filled in nicely and are in good condition. The greens have been more of a challenge but overall are also in good shape.

A few greens thinned in coverage slightly when they remained wet through a warm week. Disease developed on these greens but were sprayed immediately with a fungicide. We also spiked and aerated to help provide air to the rootzone. Thin areas will soon be topdressed with a thin layer of sand to help in recovery. The back driving range tee has been closed and seeded with bermudagrass. Some areas on the tee will soon be seeded again due to the washing of seed following a heavy rainstorm. We will push growth on the tee aggressively and hope to have it open near the end of July. Weeds throughout the course have been sprayed and we will continue to do so as needed. July is typically our most difficult month to keep the turf healthy. Water management will be the key on greens as the root system is not as strong as I would like. If we continue to receive weekly rains, our only challenge with the bermudagrass is keeping it mowed.

Please continue to help us out by driving ninety degrees to your ball, fill divots, and repair ball marks. Thanks!
