# TURF TALK

Summer weather has arrived, and a more "normal" weather pattern has emerged. Rainfall rates are down, and temperatures are closer to average as compared to last season. We have taken full advantage of our beneficial growing weather by optimizing our turf care programs for maximum sustained growth. On greens we continue to fertilize, vent and apply plant protection products that will help the turf survive our rigorous summer weather. Thin areas are being plugged and sanded to help facilitate stolon growth and aid in full recovery.

We thank you for your patience as we continue to irrigate greens in the afternoon in order to lower surface temperatures and help to alleviate stress. Fairways and tees have all been aerated and fertilized to help promote healthier turf. A growth regulator has been applied to promote lateral, rather than vertical plant growth. It also reduces clipping yield and improves turf density. Roughs will be aerated this month and weed control products applied to alleviate weed pressures.

We look forward to seeing you on the course this summer.
