TURF TALK

The summer heat is on. Remember that we will be watering greens as needed to beat the heat during afternoon hours. Though inconvenient, it is an essential practice on cool season grasses that helps the turf survive during periods of heat stress.

Another agronomic issue that we will continue to discuss is the **90 degree cart rule**. Please adhere to it! This simple practice will reduce cart traffic on fairways and result in a noticeable improvement in overall course conditions. Improperly driven carts result in extensive and unnecessary damage suffered annually. Recent rainfall has helped with course green up as we prepare to fertilize fairways and tees.

It looks like we dodged the *Brood X Cicadas*! Fear not we got plenty of them about 20 miles north of Lee's Hill. My commute this past month was punctuated with windshield splats. Fair well Brood X, see you guys again in 17 years! We still have plenty of other Cicada species in our area that will provide food for the Cicada Killer Wasps that we will witness shortly. Fortunately they are generally harmless and only sting when harassed. We will do the best we can to control them this summer.

Hope you have enjoyed an early kickoff to summer and we will see you soon on the course!
