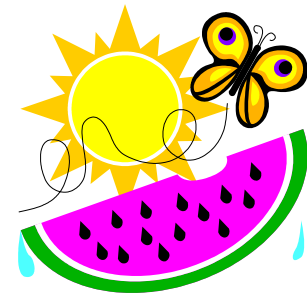

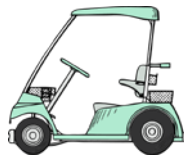
Robert E Lee Cup

TURF TALK

As expected July has been a difficult month for the maintenance team and the golf course. We were extremely dry starting the month off but 3 inches of rain after the first week really greened up the turf. Fairways and tees recovered quickly and are still in good condition. The problems however then began on greens, as temperatures have remained in the mid to upper 90's.

Poa annua (our primary turf type on greens) is a cool season grass with a shallow root system. Due to its limited roots we are forced to keep them more saturated than we would like, which combined with heat and humidity causes thinning and disease.

Greens that do not get good air movement and receive lots of traffic in one area suffered the most. These greens are 4,5,13, and 15. This week we are expecting a little dip in temperatures so we will aerate greens with small solid tines, topdress lightly, and apply some fertilizer to aid in recovery. Cooler night-time temperatures with less humidity would benefit us greatly, allowing the turf to breathe and dry out.

Please understand that we are doing everything we can to keep these greens alive and playable through August. I realize they are slower than many would like, but we are trying to make it to September with as much turf as possible. We then can speed them back up as they get healthier.
