### **TURF TALK**

What a difference a month makes. After receiving about 12 inches of rain in early to mid-June, we found ourselves not receiving any rain again until the last week of July. This weather combination was terrible for growing grass particularly on our greens. On Sunday, July 1<sup>st</sup> we found ourselves with no ability to water first thing in the morning as our "VFD" variable frequency drive to our pumps went out and we determined we needed a new \$6K drive to be able to get water on the course again. We were fortunate that we purchased and installed a new VFD drive that same day but it happened to be on the hottest day of the year.

### **Turf Talk Continued.....**

The temperature reached nearly 100 degrees with a heat index of 110 and that proved to be more than much of the poa annua grass on the greens could endure. Once we installed our new VFD drive, we found that we still had no water pressure due to a main line irrigation break on the driving range. As a result, that irrigation break had to be repaired before we could have enough water pressure to water the greens. We finally were able to get water on the greens by mid-afternoon but in the meantime the greens were under some severe stress and took a turn for the worse. After taking this high dose of heat without water for a small period of time, the bent grass on the greens survived but the poa annua grass on the greens did not do as well. About a week later, our Superintendent Brian, accepted another position and resigned. We wish him well for the ten years of service and dedication to Lee's Hill.

I would like to thank Ed, Shawn and the rest of the maintenance staff for their dedication and effort to keeping the greens alive over the past month with no rain especially since the greens were in a very weakened state due to the very shallow roots explained in last month's Turf Talk by Brian. During the last several weeks without a Superintendent in place, the maintenance team all stepped up to the plate and did what needed to be done to keep us in a position to recover from our equipment failure earlier in July. I am also very excited to announce that our new Superintendent, John Burns will be here to start at Lee's Hill on Monday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. John has worked with Shawn, Chuck and I in past years in the Fredericksburg area at both The Gauntlet and Augustine golf course. John and his wife are relocating back to Virginia from Florida and we are very happy to have them here. Feel free to reach out to John and welcome him to both Lee's Hill and the Fredericksburg area when you see him out on the course in the near future.

As always, we appreciate your continued loyalty and support. We are now looking forward to getting through the final summer month of August and finding some much needed cooler temperatures and better weather as we enter the fall season. We are looking forward to transitioning into a great time of year for growing grass and also a beautiful time of the year to play golf!
